

RULES FOR ST. PETER'S T-BALL LEAGUE

HAVE FUN!

Every player bats and plays in the field each inning.

The ball is hit off a batting tee; there is no pitching.

There are no walks or strikeouts.

There are traditional outs, fly balls, force out, etc.

The ball must travel 10 feet or it is a foul.

No fielder may cross the playing line until the ball is hit.

No stealing. Player stays on the base until the ball is hit.

An inning is over when all the players have batted once. If anyone is left on base have them continue to run the bases to home when the last batter hits.

Safety helmets must be worn.

Scores are not kept.

The "Pitcher" should simulate the pitch to each batter.

The game is 50 minutes long - usually 2 full innings.
